ADVENT REFLECTION FROM FATHER PAT

One of the central figures in our Advent liturgies is John the Baptist, who comes out of the desert to proclaim the arrival of the Kingdom of God.

John went into the desert to prepare himself for the work that God was calling him to perform. In the desert, John let go of what we usually depend on. He let go of his dependency on other people's approval. There were no other people there in the desert. He had to rely solely on his
